

## **CHAPTER – 3**

### **PUBLICATIONS WHICH FILED ANNUAL STATEMENT FOR 2017-18**

**3.1.** Under Section 19(D) of the PRB Act, 1867, it is mandatory for every registered publication to submit an Annual Statement to the Office of the Registrar of Newspapers for India. The Annual Statements are the principal source of data for compilation of the Annual Report of the Registrar of Newspapers for India called “PRESS IN INDIA”. The RNI has taken steps to facilitate the process of filing of the annual statements by the publishers and an online system of e-filing of Annual Statements put in place in our website. However, it is observed that not all the publishers are submitting their Annual Statements. Non-compliance with the above provision of the Act by publishers has so far precluded this office from claiming this report to be a comprehensive data bank of the print media in India. However, in order to make this report a more meaningful document with authentic statistical information, the Annual Statements received from the publishers online for the year 2017-18 have only been taken into account in this chapter. Out of 1,18,239 registered newspapers & periodicals as many as 30,117 submitted their Annual Reports online. The chapter depicts a general trend in the Print Media in the country on the basis of various parameters such as – Periodicity-wise, Language-wise, State-wise, City-wise, Small Town-wise, etc.

#### **DAILIES**

**3.2.1.** During the year 2017-18, as many as 8,930 daily publications submitted their Annual Statements. These were being brought out in all the languages listed in the Eighth Schedule of the Indian Constitution. Among the dailies, Hindi retained its top position in the list with 3,838 Dailies while other languages with more than 200 Dailies are (i) Urdu (1,145) (ii) Telugu (950), (iii) English (815), (iv) Marathi (540) , (v) Gujarati (445) and (vi) Kannada (426). (Table 3.1)

#### **PERIODICALS**

**3.3.** A total number of 21,187 publications of various periodicities (except Dailies) submitted their Annual Statements for 2017-18. Out of these, 10,834 were Weeklies; 6,138 Monthlies; 2,836 Fortnightlies; 522 Quarterlies and 94 Annuals. There are 763 periodicals i.e. Bi-monthly, Half-yearly etc., which are categorized as other periodicities. Weeklies and Monthlies with their total number at 16,972 appeared to be more popular, accounting for nearly 56.35 per cent of the total periodicals. (Table 3.1)

#### **LANGUAGE-WISE ANALYSIS**

**3.4.1.** As per the circulation data available, publications were brought out in 45 languages and dialects in 2017-18. Apart from English and other principal languages, listed in the Eighth

Schedule of the Indian Constitution, publications were also published in 22 other languages or dialects mostly Indian and a few foreign languages. Other languages in which publications came

out were Ao Naga, Arabic, Bhojpuri, Chhattisgarhi, Sindhi Devnagri, Garo, Garhwali, Halbi, Karbi, Khasi, Khortha, Kharia, Kokborok, Meeteilon, Mizo Lushai, Naga, Nagpuri, Rajasthani, Santhali, Tenyidie and Tulu .

**3.4.2.** Among the publications of different languages which submitted their Annual Statements during 2017-18, the highest number of publications were in Hindi (15,327) followed by English (2,393), Marathi (2,243), Gujarati (1,954), Telugu (1,933), Urdu (1,739), Kannada (891), Tamil (520), Bengali (499), Odia (413) and Malayalam (313) etc. (Table 3.1)

**3.4.3.** Apart from publications brought out in one language, there were also quite a number of publications which were brought out in two or more languages in the same issue. Such publications were categorized as 'Bi-lingual' and 'Multi-lingual'. There were 1,377 'Bilingual' and 161 'Multilingual' in the country.

## STATE-WISE ANALYSIS

**3.5.1.** Uttar Pradesh with 5,630 publications filing their online Annual Statements in 2017-18 retained its top position among the states. Madhya Pradesh with (4,688) publications came next followed by Maharashtra (3,472); Delhi (2,185); Gujarat (2,127); Uttarakhand (1,867); Rajasthan (1,748); and Andhra Pradesh (1,716). Other States from where more than 300 publications filed their online Annual Statements were Karnataka (1,075); Telangana (845); Tamil Nadu (741); West Bengal (638); Odisha (519); Chhattisgarh (509); J & K (403); Kerala (396) and Haryana (301). (Table 3.2)

**3.5.2.** In the category of Dailies also, Uttar Pradesh maintained its lead with 1,963 daily publications followed by Madhya Pradesh (962); Andhra Pradesh (856); Maharashtra (742); Delhi (589); Gujarat (541); and Karnataka (489); Daily newspapers were published from almost all the States and Union Territories except Lakshadweep. (Table 3.2)

**3.5.3.** About 56.35 per cent of the periodicals being published were either Weeklies or Monthlies. Out of 21,187 periodicals (except Dailies), about 51.13 per cent were held by Weeklies only. The largest number of Weeklies were being published from Uttar Pradesh (2,623); followed by Maharashtra (1,895); Madhya Pradesh (1,461); Uttarakhand (1,287); Gujarat (1,102); Delhi (542) and Rajasthan (380). (Table 3.2)

**3.5.4.** About 28.97 per cent of the total number of periodicals being published were Monthlies. The largest number of Monthlies were published from Madhya Pradesh (1,823) followed by Delhi (637) Uttar Pradesh (595); Andhra Pradesh (532) and Maharashtra (441). Other states publishing more than 150 monthlies were Tamil Nadu (311); Karnataka (236);

Telangana (225); Gujarat (194); Kerala (166); Rajasthan (165); Chhattisgarh (157) and Uttarakhand (155). (Table 3.2)

**3.5.5.** Delhi and Maharashtra brought out publications in 16 languages each followed by Karnataka and Uttarakhand in 12 languages each, Gujarat and West Bengal in 11 languages each, Andhra Pradesh and Puducherry in 10 languages each out of 22 main languages (excluding English) listed in the Eighth Schedule of the Indian Constitution). (Table 3.3)

**3.5.6.** The distinction for bringing out the highest number of publications in a single language went to Uttar Pradesh, where 4,485 publications were brought out in Hindi. The other States with over 500 publications in Hindi were Madhya Pradesh (4,384); Uttarakhand (1,707); Rajasthan (1,586) and Delhi (1,211). (Table 3.3)

**3.5.7.** States with more than 200 publications in a single language were (i) Delhi (Hindi 1,211) and (English 488); (ii) Andhra Pradesh (Telugu 1,409); (iii) Gujarat (Gujarati 1,878); (iv) Maharashtra (Marathi 2,207), (Hindi 474) and English (364); (v) Uttar Pradesh (Hindi 4,485) and Urdu (758); (vi) West Bengal (Bengali 430); (vii) Tamil Nadu (Tamil 476); (viii) Odisha (Odia 406); (ix) Kerala (Malayalam 296); (x) Karnataka (Kannada 873); (xi) Chhattisgarh (Hindi 471); (xii) Haryana (Hindi 247); (xiii) Madhya Pradesh (Hindi 4,384); (xiv) Telangana (Telugu 505); (xv) Uttarakhand (Hindi 1,707); (xvi) Rajasthan (Hindi 1,586) (Table 3.3)

### **CONCENTRATION**

**3.6.** The Print Media tends to concentrate in certain important Cities and Towns, giving them prominence as major printing and publishing centers, which can be classified as under:

- (i) Metropolitan Cities (Delhi, Kolkata, Mumbai and Chennai),
- (ii) State Capitals (other than the Metropolitan Cities),
- (iii) Union Territories,
- (iv) Big Cities, (having a population of more than 1,00,000), and
- (v) Small Towns. (having a population of less than 1,00,000)

### **LANGUAGE-WISE ANALYSIS**

**3.7.** Among those publications, which submitted their Annual Statements online during 2017-18, Language wise analysis of publications shows that out of 15,327 Hindi publications, 6,433 were brought out from the State Capitals; 5,303 from the Big Cities and 2,037 from the Smaller Towns. Out of 2,393 publications in English, 957 were brought out from the four Metropolitan Cities. The other languages in which a large number of publications came out from the Metropolitan Cities were Hindi (1,503); Tamil (285), Marathi (245) and Urdu (238). The four metropolitan cities published 324 Bilingual and 22 Multilingual publications. (Table 3.4)

### NUMERICAL ANALYSIS

**3.8.1.** The total number of publications brought out from the four metropolitan cities during 2017-18 was 3,873 accounting for 12.86 per cent of the total publications. State Capitals (excluding the Metropolitan Cities) published 9,697 publications constituting 32.20 per cent of the total. Big cities published a total of 12,561 publications constituting 41.71 per cent. Thus the Big cities dominated the number of publications in India in 2017-18. A total of 3,795 publications came out from Small Towns and 191 from Union Territories. (Table 3.5)

**3.8.2.** Out of 8,930 dailies, a total of 903 were being published from the Metropolitan Cities and 2,694 from the State Capitals. The Big Cities in various States published 4,083 Dailies and Small Towns brought out 1,150 Daily newspapers. The Union Territories published only 100 Dailies. (Table 3.5)
