

III. NUMBER OF PUBLICATIONS

3.1. Under Section 19D of the Act, it is mandatory for every registered publications to submit an Annual Statement to the Office of the Registrar of Newspapers for India. The Annual Statements are the principal source of data for compilation of this report, yet not all the publishers are submitting their Annual Statements. Hence, non-compliance of the above provision of the Act by publishers has so far precluded this office from claiming this report to be a comprehensive data bank. However, in order to make this report a more meaningful document with authentic statistical information, Annual Statements received from the publishers online for the year 2013-14 have only been taken into account in this chapter. Out of 99,660 registered newspapers & periodicals 19,499 have submitted their Annual Reports online. The chapter gives a general trend of the Print Media in the country – Periodicity-wise, Language-wise, State-wise, City-wise, Small Town-wise, etc.

DAILIES

3.2.1. During the year 2013-14, the total number of Annual Statements submitted by daily publications is 6,730. These are being brought out in all the languages listed in the Eighth Schedule of the Constitution. Among dailies, Hindi retained its top position in the list with 3,213 dailies while other languages with more than 200 dailies are (i) Urdu (929) (ii) English (695), (iii) Telugu (562), Marathi (280) and Gujarati (292). (Table 3.1)

3.2.2. Apart from dailies, tri & bi-weekly publications also play an important role in dissemination of information/news to keep the readers abreast of latest happenings/events in and outside the country. In this category, annual statements were received from 25 publications of different Languages. (Table 3.1)

PERIODICALS

3.3. A total number of 12,744 publications of various periodicities (except dailies & tri/bi weeklies) submitted their annual statements for 2013-14. Out of these, 7,033 are weeklies; 3,425 monthlies; 1,855 fortnightlies; 201 quarterlies and 55 annuals. There are 175 periodicals i.e. bi-monthly, half-yearly etc., which are categorized as other periodicities. Weeklies and monthlies appeared to be more popular, with their total number at 10,458 accounting for nearly 82.06 per cent of the total periodicals. (Table 3.1)

LANGUAGE-WISE ANALYSIS

3.4.1. As per the circulation data available, publications were published in 47 languages and dialects in 2013-14. Apart from English and other principal languages, listed in the Eighth Schedule of the Constitution, publications were published in 24 other languages or dialects mostly Indian and a few foreign languages. Other languages in which publications came out were African, Arabic, Bhojpuri, Braille, Chhattisgarhi, Sindhi Devnagri, Garo, Garhwali, German, Halbi, Hmar, Karbi, Khasi, Khortha, Kharia, Kokborok, Meeteilon, Mizo Lushai, Nagaa, Nagpuri, Rajasthani, Sinthali, Tenyidie, Tulu.

3.4.2. Among those publications which submitted their annual statements during 2013-14, the highest number of publications were in Hindi (11,184) followed by English (1,889), Urdu (1,443), Gujarati (1,046), Telugu (961), Marathi (600), Kannada (264), Oriya (289), Tamil (231), Malayalam (204) and Bengali (179), etc. (Table 3.1)

3.4.3. Apart from publications brought out in one language, there are also quite a few brought out in two or more languages in the same issue, categorized as 'Bilingual' and 'Multilingual'. There were 812 'Bilinguals' and 78 'Multilingual'.

STATE-WISE ANALYSIS

3.5.1. Uttar Pradesh with 4,827 publications retained its top position among those publications which submitted online annual statements for 2013-14. Delhi with 2,343 came next, followed by Madhya Pradesh (2,106); Uttarakhand (1,775); Maharashtra (1,098); Rajasthan (1,467); Andhra Pradesh (1,365); Gujarat (1,171); West Bengal (251); Karnataka (374); Tamil Nadu (376); Odisha (350) Kerala (254); J&K (347); Chhattisgarh (315); Bihar (202). Other States with (more than 100 publications were Punjab (164); Haryana (179), Jharkhand (119) and Assam (107). (Table 3.2)

3.5.2. In the category of dailies also, Uttar Pradesh maintained its supremacy with (1,689) followed by Andhra Pradesh (796); Delhi (599); Madhya Pradesh (609); Maharashtra (422); Rajasthan (392); Gujarat (355); Jammu & Kashmir (230) and Uttarakhand (228). Daily newspapers were published from almost all the States and Union Territories except Lakshadweep. (Table 3.2)

3.5.3. About 82.06 per cent of periodicals being published were either weeklies or monthlies. Out of this about 67.25 per cent were held by weeklies only. The largest number of weeklies were being published from Uttar Pradesh (2,380); followed by Uttarakhand (1,211); Delhi (632); Madhya Pradesh (666); Maharashtra (372); Gujarat (544) and Rajasthan (323). (Table 3.2)

3.5.4. About 32.75 per cent of periodicals being published were monthlies. The largest number of monthlies were published from Delhi (719) followed by Madhya Pradesh (684); Uttar Pradesh (444); Andhra Pradesh (297) and Maharashtra (214). Other states publishing more than 100 monthlies were Gujarat (135); Rajasthan (154); and Uttarakhand (154). (Table 3.2)

3.5.5. Delhi brought out publications in 16 languages followed by Maharashtra with 10 languages and Karnatka with 9 languages out of 23 principal languages (including English). (Table 3.3)

3.5.6. The distinction for bringing out the highest number of publications in a single language went to Uttar Pradesh, where 3,868 publications were published in Hindi. Other States with over 500 publications in Hindi were Madhya Pradesh (1959); Uttarakand (1632); Delhi (1298); and Rajasthan (1325). (Table 3.3)

3.5.7. States with more than 100 publications in a single language were (i) Delhi (English 512) and (Urdu 215); (ii) Andhra Pradesh (Telugu 938) and (English 214); (iii) Gujarat (Gujarati 1009); (iv) Maharashtra (Marathi 574), (English 229) & (Hindi 166); (v) Uttar Pradesh (Urdu 676) & English (137); (vi) West Bengal (Bengali 116); (vii) Tamil Nadu (Tamil 200) and (English 123); (viii) Odisha (Oriya 285); (ix) Kerala (Malayalam 190) and (x) Karnataka (Kannada 252). (Table 3.3)

CONCENTRATION

3.6. The Print Media tends to concentrate in certain important Cities and Towns, giving them prominence as major printing and publishing centers, which can be classified as under:

- (i) The four Metropolitan Cities i.e. Delhi, Kolkata, Mumbai and Chennai,
- (ii) State Capitals (other than the Metropolitan Cities),
- (iii) Union Territories,
- (iv) Other Big Cities and
- (v) Small Towns.

LANGUAGE-WISE ANALYSIS

3.7. Among those publications, which submitted annual statements during 2013-14, the total numbers of publications in English were 1,889 out of which 843 (44.63 per cent) are being brought out from the four metropolitan cities. Other languages in which a large number of publications come out from the Metropolitan Cities were Hindi (1,688); Urdu (245); and Tamil (118). The four metropolitan cities published 273 bilingual and 21 multilingual publications. (Table 3.4)

NUMERICAL ANALYSIS

3.8.1. The total number of publications published from the four metropolitan cities during 2013-14 was 3,459 accounting for 17.74% of the total publications. State Capitals (excluding the Metropolitan Cities) published 6,328 publications constituting 32.45 per cent of the total. Big cities published a total of 7,264 publications constituting 37.25 per cent. Thus the big cities dominated the number of publications in India in 2013-14. A total of 2,309 publications came out from Small Towns and 139 publications from Union Territory. (Table 3.5)

3.8.2. Out of 6,330 dailies, a total of 906 dailies were being published from the Metropolitan Cities and 1,956 from State Capitals. Big Cities in various States published 2,923 dailies and Small Town brought out 863 daily newspapers. Union Territories published only 82 dailies. (Table 3.5)

CITY-WISE ANALYSIS

3.9.1. The number of publications in a city reflects the reach & power of the print media and its hold on the public opinion. An exact categorization is not possible but over the years, a base strength of 100 publications has been found to be a reliable pointer. The 32 cities given in Table 3.6 published more than 100 publications each during 2013-14. The total number of publications from these 32 cities comes to 12,085, which accounted for 61.98 per cent of total publications.

(a) Cities that published more than 200 Publications: Delhi (2,317); Lucknow (1,948); Dehradun (1,249); Bhopal (1,146); Jaipur (620); Mumbai (339); Ahmadabad (353); Hyderabad (513); Kanpur (276); Chennai (211); Haridwar (232); Indore (284); Meerut (208). (Table 3.6)

3.9.2. The largest number of publications in English was published from Delhi (505), followed by Mumbai (165). Publications in Hindi were mainly brought out from Lucknow (1,511); Delhi (1,283); Dehradun (1,145); Bhopal (1,059); Jaipur (518); Kanpur (183); Haridwar (212); Indore (261); Meerut (190); Raipur (172); Ghaziabad (141) and Gwalior (126). (Table 3.6)
