**Subject: Extension of validity of Circulation Verification (CV)
Certificates until 30.06.2025**

The Government of India has notified the Press & Registration of Periodicals Act (PRP Act), 2023 and its Rules in the Gazette and consequently, the Act/Rules have come into force from 1st March, 2024. As per Section 6(b) of the PRP Act, the Press Registrar General of India (PRGI) may undertake the verification of circulation figures of a periodical in such manner and for such purpose, as may be prescribed.

2. In this context, it is to inform that the draft **Guidelines for the Circulation Verification of Periodicals through Desk-Audit** are currently undergoing further amendment with a view to simplifying the process and ensuring smooth implementation.

In view of the above, it is informed that **the validity of the Circulation Verification Certificates of those newspapers who have applied for Circulation Verification (FY 2023-24) to PRGI (as per ADVISORY No.32 of 2024 and ADVISORY No.1 of 2025) is extended till 30.06.2025 or until the issuance of the new CV Certificate, whichever is earlier.**

This issues with the approval of Press Registrar General.
