ADVISORY No. 39 of 2025

Subject: Delivery of Physical Copies of Periodicals as per Rule 10(2) of the Press and Registration of Periodicals Rules, 2024-reg.

This is to advise all Publishers that they may deliver the physical copy of the newspaper, in accordance with Rule 10(2) of the Press and Registration of Periodicals Rules, 2024, which says ***"The Publisher in a State or Union Territory shall deliver the physical copy of the newspaper to the office of the Press Information Bureau located in that State or Union Territory in which the paper is being published, by the 5th day of every month for all the days for which the newspaper is published during the preceding month."***

2. In order to streamline the process and facilitate ease of compliance with the above requirement, the following instructions are hereby issued with immediate effect:

- Periodicals published within the National Capital Territory (NCT) of Delhi shall submit the physical copy of each issue to the Office of the Press Registrar General of India (O/o PRGI), New Delhi by the 5th day of every month for all days for which the newspaper is published during the preceding month.
- Periodicals published in the National Capital Region (NCR), excluding the NCT of Delhi — i.e., those published from areas of Haryana, Uttar Pradesh and Rajasthan falling within the NCR — shall submit the physical copy at the nearest Press Information Bureau (PIB) office such as PIB, Delhi.

3. Accordingly, Publishers are requested to ensure strict compliance with these provisions within the stipulated timelines to avoid any regulatory inconvenience.
