**ADVISORY No. 40 of 2025**

**Subject: Registration of New Editions of existing Periodicals -reg.**

It has been observed that numerous publishers intending to launch new editions of their already registered titles are submitting applications under an incorrect registration category on the Press Sewa Portal.

2. In this context, it is hereby clarified that if the proposed new edition is to be published from a different state—i.e., if the state of publication of the existing periodical differs from that of the proposed new edition—the publisher is required to apply under the New Registration category. This procedure ensures proper verification of title availability within the new state from which the edition is intended to be published.

3. Accordingly, all publishers are advised to strictly adhere to the aforementioned guideline when submitting applications for new editions of their periodicals.
