Subject: Extension of Last Date for e-Filing of Annual Statements for FY 2025-26 on Press Sewa Portal -REG.

In continuation of Advisory No. 10 of 2026 dated 22.05.2026 issued by the Office of the Press Registrar General of India regarding the submission of the Annual Statement for the Financial Year 2025-2026 under the provisions of the Press and Registration of Periodicals (PRP) Act, 2023, it is hereby informed that the last date for submission of the Annual Statement through the Press Sewa Portal has been extended up to **31st August, 2026**.

2. This extension is granted in accordance with the provisions of **Section 12(1)** of the Press and Registration of Periodicals (PRP) Act, 2023, read alongside Rule 9 of the Press and Registration of Periodicals Rules, 2024, which governs the submission timeline and mandates the Press Registrar General's authority to regulate or extend the filing window under special circumstances.

3. All publishers are required to submit the Annual Statement exclusively through online mode by logging into the Press Sewa Portal (www.presssewaportal.gov.in). **Please note that no physical submission, dak, or offline communication shall be accepted under any circumstances. Furthermore, no revision after e-filing will be allowed.**

Extended Last Date :31st August, 2026

4. Publishers are strongly advised to ensure timely submission of complete and correct information within this extended period. Submission of incomplete/incorrect information, or absolute failure to submit the Annual Statement within the prescribed time, shall attract strict action under the relevant punitive provisions of the PRP Act, 2023, including potential risk to the registration status of the publication.
